THE MONTE-CARLO COUNTRY CLUB SWIMMING-POOL YEAR 2022

These regulations concerning swimming and measures of hygiene and safety, displayed at the entrance of the establishment, are to be strictly observed.

* * *

Members of the Monte-Carlo Country Club have free access to the swimming-pool.

I - FUNCTIONING

A - FACILITIES

The swimming-pool facilities are at the disposal of the members of the MCCC and their guests, who are asked to respect them.

The facilities include:

- * A heated ozone-treated swimming-pool, with equipment for jacuzzi and counter-current swimming
- * A solarium
- * A snack-bar (open every day from 10:00am until 05:30pm proposing sweet and savoury snacks to have on your sun bed)
 - * Lounge chairs, mattresses, parasols, other accessories if available.
 - * Locker room closed for the moment

Towels are sold at cost price to the members or their guests and will remain their property.

B - OPENING TIMES

2023: from 5th May to 30th September included.

The swimming-pool is open every day:

- in May and in September, from 10:00am to 06:00pm (pool closes at 05:45pm)
- in June, from 10:00am to 07:00pm (pool closes at 06:45pm)
- in July and August, from 10:00am to 07:30pm (pool closes at 07:15pm).

The Management has the right **to change opening and closing times**, without prior notice, or partially or totally close the pool for special events, repairs or maintenance.

II - INTERNAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

A - GENERAL PROVISIONS

1) Members of the M.C.C.C. will be allowed to enter upon presenting a membership card in their name.

Any Member authorizing the use of his/her card by a non-member, could immediately be excluded from the Club, with withdrawal of his/her card without any refund.

Cards will be issued after the Director's approval and full settlement of the annual membership fees.

- 2) Members and their guests will not be admitted outside the swimming-pool area, when in swimming wear or barefoot, notably on the restaurant terrace or elsewhere in the M.C.C.C.
- **3)** Members and their guests may not change around the swimming-pool. The locker rooms must be used. No clothing is to be placed on the chairs, around the swimming-pool or in the solarium.
- 4) No glass, metal or any other sharp object is to be left around the swimming-pool or in the solarium.
- **5)** Members and their guests are asked to dress and behave appropriately inside the Club out of respect for the other members and staff.
- 6) No animals are allowed on the premises.
- **7)** Only Club Members and their guests' children will be allowed entrance. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by their parents or by an adult.

Strollers are not allowed in the swimming-pool area.

The parents or the accompanying adult are asked to ensure that the children behave correctly - no noisy or dangerous games, in particular in the splash pool.

- 8) All ball games and floating objects such as inflatable mattresses are forbidden in the swimming-pool.
- 9) No electrical apparatus i.e. radios, TVs, cassettes are allowed.
- 10) It is forbidden to use cameras, videoscopes within the premises. Mobile phones are tolerated but with discretion.
- 11) Offenders will be held entirely responsible for any infringement of these regulations.
- 12) It is forbidden to bring food and beverages from outside and to use the premises, the solarium or the terraces as a picnic area.

Cooler boxes are forbidden.

Beverages and food are served on the premises. Food, however, may not be served or eaten outside these premises.

13) The M.C.C.C. Membership card cannot be used as a credit card for food and beverages.

- **14)** In the interest of hygiene, safety and calm, access to the swimming-pool may be refused to any person who:
- * refuses to change in the premises reserved to this effect,
- * refuses to use the toilets and showers available.
- * shows signs of suspect open wounds and who, upon request, cannot provide a valid medical certificate proving non-contagion,
- * behaves inappropriately
- 15) The lifeguard and/or swimming-pool supervisors' instructions must be respected.
- **16)** The swimming-pool users are asked to behave in a manner befitting the quality of the establishment.

B - INVITATIONS

Should a Member of the M.C.C.C. wish to invite one or several persons, the following entrance fees are applicable:

- 1 From Friday May 5th to Friday June 30th June 2023 and from Friday 1st to Saturday 30th September 2023:
 - * From Monday to Friday:

Adults: 38.00 €uros Children (3-18 years): 27.00 €uros

* Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holidays:

Adults: 43.00 €uros Children (3-18 years): 30.00 €uros

2 – From 1st July to 31st August 2023:

Adults: 43.00 €uros Children (3-18 years): 30.00 €uros

To avoid any confusion when buying tickets, Members are asked to accompany their guest(s) to the ticket office, with their Membership card.

C - RESPONSIBILITIES

Members and their guests use the facilities at their own risk and peril.

The M.C.C.C. accepts no responsibility in case of damage, theft or loss of personal objects.

The M.C.C.C. is not responsible for any incident occurring outside official opening times.

D - OBSERVANCE OF REGULATIONS

The regulations stated in this document must be strictly observed by the Members and their guests.

No refund will be made to persons violating the above rules and regulations.
